



## Clery Act Campus Security Authorities (CY 2015)

The Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Police and Campus Crime Statistics Act (“Clery Act”) and the Higher Education Act of 1965 require Colleges and Universities to disclose statistics for crimes reported on or surrounding the campus. Institutions are required to collect crime reports received by individuals associated with the institution who have been identified as Campus Security Authorities (“CSAs”). At the University of Kansas, School of Medicine (KUSM-W), the following individuals have been identified as CSAs for **CY 2015\***:
