

Pre-Employment Drug Screening

Prior to beginning the residency program, but after you have accepted the Letter of Appointment and Resident Agreement, you will need to undergo a pre-employment drug screening, as required by the Resident Agreement of Appointment and Employment, Section III, Position (iii). The WCGME office will provide the necessary paperwork for you to sign, including but not limited to a Consent form and List of Current Prescribed Medication. If you are taking any prescribed medication, it will be helpful for you to have the prescription information available in order to complete any pre-testing forms. The testing is performed off-site. A positive test result is a violation of the contract and the agreement may be terminated if test results show a designated level of non-prescribed substance. A refusal to submit to the pre-employment testing will also result in termination of the Resident Agreement. These terminations are not subject to WCGME's Grievance Policy.
