

KUSM-Wichita Human Subjects Committee 2 FY2010 Fees

The institutional review board of the University of Kansas School of Medicine-Wichita, called the Human Subjects Committee 2 (HSC2), charges for review of “industry-sponsored” (e.g. pharmaceutical companies) research protocols.

The fees below apply to all reviews of industry-sponsored protocols. KUSM-W department, non-profit, state or federal government (NIH, NCI, etc.) sponsored studies are not to subject to this fee.

Type of HSC2 Review	Fee
Initial Review – Full Committee	\$2,000
Administrative Fee – one time, up front charge	\$1,000
Continuing Review	\$ 500
Amendments – Full Committee	\$ 500
Amendments – Expedited	\$ 500

Fee Details

Initial Review - Full Committee

- Time and effort of review of study by full committee.

Administrative Fee

- One-time, up front fee to cover administrative costs incurred for the life of the project, e.g., copies, administrative review time, official HSC2 correspondence, training and conflict of interest compliance.

Continuing Review

- Time and effort of review to continue an existing study by full committee.

Amendments – Full Committee or Expedited Review

- Time and effort of review by full committee or by paid HSC2 reviewer.
- Billable expedited amendments include protocol, informed consent or investigator brochure amendments.
